We put birds on our fall tree and have introduced birds into our classroom. We have been pretending to fly like birds and tweet like birds. Birds eat special food that we held in our hands and pretended to feed the birds. Then we went outside and put out some food for the birds that live outside. We continuously add new toys to the classroom to excite the children in their play and broaden their experiences. We placed pictures of the children at their eye level so they can interact with the photos. The children really enjoy looking at pictures of themselves and their friends and have been 'talking' to each other about the people that they see. They point to their friends or themselves and call out their name.

We also use these pictures as a reference to talk about the outdoors before we go outside. Continuously using these new words will help us practice saying them and understanding their meanings and will help us incorporate these new words into our future communications.
